Jelka Ovaska (1947, Ljubljana, Slovenia) spent some years living in Finland (1971–1977). She is also a well-known and awarded translator of Finnish literature. Polaris over Olympus takes us from Greece to Finland, with stop-overs in Provence, Paris, Lisbon and Belgrade, and presents readers with a paradox: the product of the steamy Mediterranean is a deep-frozen man, whereas cold Finland has nursed a hot-blooded woman whose passion has not diminished with age. The love story between 67-year-old Greek entrepreneur and Finnish lady, a 62-year-old divorced professor, fights the taboo that eroticism is only for the young and best to be forgotten later in life.
